TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO, TO SOLICIT REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT(S) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES TO THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO, FOR DESIGN AND BIDDING DOCUMENT PREPARATION FOR THE GRANDVIEW AND PINE AVENUE SEWER IMPROVEMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13243/2023

WHEREAS, both the Grandview and Pine Avenue Sanitary Sewers have identified bottlenecks due to undersized downstream sewers; and

WHEREAS, these bottlenecks need to be addressed subsequent to the completion of other downstream sewer improvements, including the Niles Road Sewer Reconfiguration; and

WHEREAS, prerequisite projects are about to start construction, enabling the initiation of the process of addressing these identified sewer bottlenecks; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, Ohio to solicit requests for qualifications from an engineering firm to design the sewer improvements needed to reduce the bottlenecks in the downstream portions of the Grandview and Pine Avenue Sewers, to prepare bid documents and to enter into a contract(s) according to Law for conducting the aforementioned sewer design and subsequent construction bidding process.

Section 2: That any contract(s) to be entered into or participated in for these purposes on behalf of the Water Pollution Control Department shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, welfare, and safety. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
