TITLE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY PURSUANT TO SECTION 721.15(C) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE TO DISCARD MUNICIPALLY-OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT IS NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE OR PUBLIC USE, OR IS OBSOLETE, OR IS UNFIT FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE OR PUBLIC USE AND HAS NO VALUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13222/2023

WHEREAS, Section 721.15(C) - Disposition of property unneeded, obsolete or unfit for municipal purposes of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the legislative authority of a Municipal Corporation, under particular circumstances, to discard municipally-owned personal property of the City that is no longer needed for any municipal purpose or public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for any municipal purpose or public use and has no value; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren, Ohio is the owner of municipally-owned personal property that is no longer needed for any municipal purpose or public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for any municipal purpose or public use, and has no value; and

WHEREAS, said municipally-owned personal property, as fully rewritten herein, has no value, is no longer needed, nor serves municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, this Council and the Administration of the City of Warren, Ohio desires to exercise the authority granted pursuant to said Section 721.15(C) - Disposition of property no longer needed, obsolete, or unfit for municipal purposes of the Ohio Revised Code; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That this Council and the Administration of the City of Warren, Ohio, hereby determines that the municipally-owned personal property as fully rewritten herein, is no longer needed for any municipal purpose or public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for any municipal purpose or public use, and has no value.

By discarding the following items:

Section 2: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Warren, Ohio, are hereby authorized to discard the municipally-owned personal property as fully rewritten herein.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety, and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed with the disposal of the municipally-owned personal property at the earliest possible time and without undue delay as said properties are no longer needed for any Municipal purpose. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
