TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE EASTGATE REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE ARTERIAL SIDEWALKS PHASE 3 PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13272/2023

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments, administers financial assistance for public improvement projects through the Transportation Alternatives Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren desires financial assistance through the Transportation Alternatives Program for the Arterial Sidewalks Phase 3 Project; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Warren City Council hereby approves filing an application for financial assistance through the Transportation Alternatives Program for the Arterial Sidewalks Phase 3 Project.

SECTION 2: That the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby is, authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to execute and file an application with the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance for the following:

Arterial Sidewalks Phase 3 Project

The project will consist of repairing sidewalks as needed on Palmyra Road, Parkman Road, Tod Avenue, Highland Avenue, Main Avenue, South Street, and Niles Road.

SECTION 3: That the Auditor of the City of Warren agrees to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and to become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Transportation Alternatives Program.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety, and for the further reason that the City of Warren may timely comply with funding and programming deadlines established by the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
