TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO CONTRACT(S) FOR THE COSTS OF RESURFACING AND OTHERWISE IMPROVING ONE OR MORE MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT(S) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13200/2023

WHEREAS, this Council passed Ordinance #13173/2022, which authorized the issuance and sale of bonds to pay the costs of resurfacing and otherwise improving one or more municipal parking lots; and

WHEREAS, the City has sold those bonds and is now prepared to proceed with the project(s) of resurfacing and improving one or more municipal parking lot(s); NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized to advertise for bids for the costs for resurfacing and otherwise improving one or more municipal parking lots in accordance with plans and specifications therefore on file in the office of the Director of Public Service and Safety. After advertising for bids according to law, the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety are hereby authorized to enter into whatever contract(s) that may be useful or necessary to accomplish the said purpose.

Section 2: That said contract(s) shall be paid for by funds including but not limited to the proceeds of the bonds.

Section 3: That the contract(s) shall be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety, and for the further reason that the resurfacing and otherwise improving the municipal parking lot(s) of the City of Warren may be more fully ensured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
