## TITLE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY PURSUANT TO SECTION 721.15(C) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE TO DISCARD MUNICIPAL PERSONAL PROPERTY (INCLUDING MOTOR VEHICLES AND/OR ROAD MACHINERY) THAT IS NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE OR PUBLIC USE, OR IS OBSOLETE, OR IS UNFIT FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE OR PUBLIC USE AND HAS NO VALUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13208/2023

WHEREAS, Section 721.15(C) - Disposition of property unneeded, obsolete or unfit for municipal purposes of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the legislative authority of a Municipal Corporation, under particular circumstances, to discard municipal personal property of the City (including motor vehicles and/or road machinery) that is no longer needed for any municipal purpose or public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for any municipal purpose or public use and has no value; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren, Ohio is the owner of municipal personal property (including motor vehicles and/or road machinery) that is no longer needed for any municipal purpose or public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for any municipal purpose or public use, and has no value; and

WHEREAS, said municipal personal properties (including motor vehicles and/or road machinery), as fully rewritten herein, have no value, are no longer needed, nor serve municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, this Council and the Administration of the City of Warren, Ohio desires to exercise the authority granted pursuant to said Section 721.15(C) - Disposition of property no longer needed, obsolete, or unfit for municipal purposes of the Ohio Revised Code; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That this Council and the Administration of the City of Warren, Ohio, hereby determines that the municipal personal property (including motor vehicles and/or road machinery as fully rewritten herein, is no longer needed for any municipal purpose or public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for any municipal purpose or public use, and has no value.
