AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO, TO SOLICIT REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT(S) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES TO THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO FOR DESIGN AND BIDDING DOCUMENT PREPARATION FOR THE RISHER ROAD AREA SEWER PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13311/2024

WHEREAS, properties along and around Risher Road, and portions of Martin Luther King Blvd, Pershing, and South Leavitt Roads have no local sewer to which they can connect; and

WHEREAS, the design and construction of new sanitary and storm sewers along these roads and others in that proximity will make it more economically feasible for new residential and commercial buildings to be constructed; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, Ohio, to solicit requests for qualifications from an engineering firm to design the sanitary and storm sewers needed to service Risher Road and portions of Martin Luther King Blvd, Pershing, and South Leavitt Roads and others in that proximity, to prepare bid documents, and to enter into a contract(s) according to Law for conducting the aforementioned sewer design and subsequent construction bidding process.

Section 2: That any contract(s) to be entered into or participated in for these purposes on behalf of the Water Pollution Control Department shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose, and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety. The further reason that immediate approval is necessary, at the earliest possible time, is to allow for upgrades and to maintain the integrity of the City of Warren, Ohio, Waste Water Facilities. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
