TITLE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY PURSUANT TO SECTION 721.15(D) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, TO DISCARD MUNICIPALLY-OWNED VEHICLES AND OTHER EQUIPMENT THAT IS NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE OR PUBLIC USE, OR IS OBSOLETE, OR IS UNFIT FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE OR PUBLIC USE AND HAS NO VALUE, VIA INTERNET AUCTION FOR THE 2024 CALENDAR YEAR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13326/2024

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15(D) authorizes the legislative authority of a municipal corporation to sell personal property, including motor vehicles acquired for the use of municipal officers and departments, and road machinery, equipment, tools, or supplies, which are not needed for public use, or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired, by internet auction; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15(D) also authorizes the legislative authority to pass legislation one time to be used for the entire calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren, Ohio is the owner of personal property, including municipally owned vehicles and equipment, and that is no longer needed for any municipal purpose or public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for any municipal purpose or public use, and has no value; and

WHEREAS, this Council and the Administration of the City of Warren, Ohio desires to exercise the authority granted pursuant to said Section 721.15(D) - Disposition of property no longer needed, obsolete, or unfit for municipal purposes of the Ohio Revised Code; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That this Council and the Administration of the City of Warren, Ohio, hereby determines that the municipally owned personal property, including vehicles and other equipment, that are deemed no longer needed for any municipal purpose or public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for any municipal purpose or public use, and has no value.

Section 2: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Warren, Ohio, are hereby authorized to discard the municipally owned personal property via internet auction for the 2024 calendar year.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety. The further reason is so the Administration may proceed with the disposal of the municipally owned personal property, including vehicles and other equipment, via internet auction, at the earliest possible time and without undue delay as said properties are no longer needed for any Municipal purpose. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
