2885	4417/09	A resolution urging ODOT and Amtrak to request 30 million dollars from the federal stimulus for Cleveland-Youngstown-Pittsburgh passenger rail capital improvements.

2880	12176/09	An ordinance to modify various appropriations from the city's general fund and special revenue funds for 2009 in light of the auditor's recertification of 2009 revenue.
