COMMON NUISANCE VIOLATIONS

Property Maintenance (Health Division):

Abandoned; unlicensed; or inoperable; vehicles;
Overgrown trees and bushes;
Tall grass and weeds;
Dilapidated structures - sheds, garages, etc.;
Broken windows, missing or torn screens, missing siding;
Missing gutters and downspouts;
Sanitation or pestilence problems;
Dog feces and dog odors;
Rubbish or accumulation of debris, building materials, objects, etc;
Indoor furniture, appliances, trash and/or junk on front or rear porches;
Unsafe porches, steps, guardrails, handrails, poorly constructed second and third floor egress landing and stairways;
Improperly boarded windows, doors and structures;
Structures in need of paint;

Building Department:

Illegal and overcrowded units;
Structures built or divided without obtaining required permits;
Operating a commercial business in a residential area;

Police Department:

Suspicious or Illegal activity (suspicion of drug dealing or prostitution);
Parking in front yard, grassy areas;

Sanitation Department:

Trash cans in proper location behind structure;
