TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO, TO SOLICIT REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS FROM AN ENGINEERING FIRM AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT(S) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO FOR THE DESIGN OF THE HIGH STREET SANITARY SEWER AND/OR PUMP STATION ON BEHALF OF THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 12847/19

WHEREAS, the City of Warren, Ohio owns, operates and maintains a sanitary sewage collection system in conformity with all Government and EPA Regulations; and

WHEREAS, in the year 2006, the City of Warren completed construction of the Downtown Sewer Separation Projects which converted the combined collection system of the downtown area into separate storm and sanitary systems; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren subsequently discovered that the sanitary laterals of approximately six (6) commercial customers in the area of High Street, N.E. and Elm Road, N.E. were inadvertently left connected to what is now the storm sewer; and

WHEREAS, the sanitary sewer which services this main area is too shallow to accept the flow from these laterals; and

WHEREAS, these inadvertent connections are against City and State regulations;
NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, Ohio to solicit requests for qualifications from an engineering firm and enter into a contract(s) according to Law for the design of the High Street Sanitary Sewer and/or Pump Station on behalf of the Water Pollution Control Facility.

Section 2: That any contract(s) to be entered into or participated in for the design of the High Street Sanitary Sewer and/or Pump Station on behalf of the Water Pollution Control Facility shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason to maintain the integrity of the City of Warren, Ohio Waste Water Facility and Pump Stations. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
