REVISED MARCH 8, 2019

THE FOLLOWING LEGISLATION WAS PASSED BY COUNCIL ON THE 27TH DAY OF FEBRUARY 2019.

3841	12849/19	An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety to advertise for bids and enter into contract(s) providing for the custodial and cleaning services for various city buildings and departments, and declaring an emergency.
3843	12850/19	An ordinance for the purpose of appropriating from the unappropriated, unencumbered 2018 balances of various city funds and transferring within the general fund and declaring an emergency.
3846	12851/19	An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety, to enter into an agreement(s) with the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC) for the 2019 Energized Community Grant(s) and accept the grant(s) for providing funds to assist the City of Warren, Ohio in implementing energy savings or energy infrastructure measures and declaring an emergency.
3847	12852/19	An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety, on behalf of the City of Warren, to enter into a personal service contract for the purpose of coordinating, directing and conducting all adult softball programs and operations in city parks during 2019, and declaring an emergency.

3844	4647/19	A resolution for the purpose of authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety, on behalf of the City of Warren, to apply for funds through the Ohio Department of Transportation for financial assistance for the Warren City Schools Safe Routes to School Program; and declaring an emergency.

FIRST READING

3842 COLBERT An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the payment of specific orders or contracts upon receipts of certification of the Fiscal Officer of the sufficiency of funds for said expenditures, and declaring an emergency.

3845 SAFFOLD An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety to amend the agreement with the Western Reserve Port Authority allowing for the transfer of additional city owned properties to the Port Authority for the purpose of economic development, and declaring an emergency.
