TITLE

A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, TO APPLY FOR FUNDS THROUGH THE EASTGATE REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE HARMON AVENUE SIDEWALKS PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RESOLUTION NO. 4621/17

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments, administers financial assistance for public improvement projects, through the Transportation Alternatives Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren desires financial assistance through the Transportation Alternatives Program for the Harmon Avenue Sidewalks Project; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Council of the City of Warren, approves filing an application for financial assistance through the Transportation Alternatives Program for the Harmon Avenue Sidewalks Project.

Section 2: That the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance for said project.

Section 3: That the Auditor of the City of Warren agrees to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and to become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the Transportation Alternatives Program.

Section 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the City of Warren may timely comply with funding and programming deadlines established by the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments. WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall go into immediate effect.
