THE FOLLOWING LEGISLATION WAS PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARREN AND SIGNED BY THE MAYOR ON THE 26TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2018.

3789	12805/18	An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety to advertise for bids and enter into a one year contract(s) or a two year contract(s) each with an additional one year renewable clause for the purchase of materials and supplies for the Water Department, and declaring an emergency.
3792	12806/18	An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to apply for federal funds programmed by the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments to improve Larchmont Avenue and Perkinswood Boulevard, and declaring an emergency.
3793	12807/18	An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to apply for federal funds programmed by the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments to improve High Street and Mahoning Avenue, and declaring an emergency.
3794	12808/18	An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to apply for federal funds programmed by the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments to improve Park Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

3790 SAFFOLD An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the filing of the Forty-Fifth Year application for a Community Development Block Grant and the Twenty-Ninth Year application for the home program under the housing and community development Act of 1990 and setting forth the projects and priorities thereunder for the year 2019, authorizing plans and specifications and contracts to accomplish said purposes upon approval of the funding therefore and establishing the budget for the FY2018 Action Plan for housing and Community Development.
