A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONFIRMING THE MAYORAL REAPPOINTMENT OF SHIRLEY BRADY AS A MEMBER OF THE CITY OF WARREN'S FAIR HOUSING COMMISSION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RESOLUTION NO. 4628/17

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 515 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Warren a Fair Housing Commission has been established for the City of Warren; and

WHEREAS, Shirley Brady currently sits as a member of the City of Warren's Fair Housing Commission; and

WHEREAS, Shirley Brady's term will expire on December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has reappointed Shirley Brady as a member of the Fair Housing Commission for a new three year term; and

WHEREAS, this Council, per Chapter 515 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Warren, desires to confirm said reappointment; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Council of the City of Warren hereby confirms the reappointment by the Mayor of the City of Warren of Shirley Brady to a three year term as a member of the City of Warren's Fair Housing Commission, beginning January 1, 2018, and ending December 31, 2020.

Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the integrity of the housing throughout the City of Warren may be more fully ensured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall go into immediate effect.
