A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF OFFERING FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL SUPPORT TO THE UNION AND MANAGEMENT EMPLOYEES AND ANY OTHER COMPANIES AFFECTED BY THE RECENT ANNOUNCEMENTS OF THE IDLING OF THE LORDSTOWN FACILITY.

WHEREAS, since the opening of the General Motors Lordstown Complex in 1966, over 16.5 million vehicles have been manufactured including the brand's best-selling car around the world, the Chevrolet Cruze officially launched in 2010 and surpassing over 3.5 million dollars in global sales; and

WHEREAS, the General Motors Lordstown Complex employs approximately 1,435 hourly employees and over 183 salaried employees for a total of 1,618 employees on one shift; and

WHEREAS, the recent announcement of the idling of the Lordstown facility is not an outcome that will be accepted by the Council and Administration of the City of Warren, elected officials including President Donald Trump, Senator Sherrod Brown, Senator Rob Portman, Congressman Tim Ryan, Congressman Bill Johnson, State Representative Michael O'Brien, State Representative Sean O'Brien, State Representative Glenn Holmes, Trumbull County Commissioners: Frank Fuda, Daniel Polivka and Mauro Cantalamessa, Governor Kasich and Governor-Elect Michael DeWine along with the citizens of the City of Warren; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent on us all as elected officials to put aside our partisan differences and work together to take up this fight for our families, our communities and for our future generations; and

WHEREAS, The City of Warren is committed to assisting the "Drive It Home Campaign" by educating all individuals involved of the importance of the General Motors Lordstown Facility to our community; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:
