AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO CONTRACT(S) WITH AN EPA-APPROVED MIXED SOLID WASTE LANDFILL OR TRANSFER FACILITY FOR THE ACCEPTANCE AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE TO BE COLLECTED BY THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 12636/16

WHEREAS, the City of Warren desires to have available to it a site for the acceptance and disposal of garbage and refuse to be collected by the City of Warren; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby is, authorized to advertise for bids from an EPA-approved mixed solid waste landfills and transfer facilities, in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Director of Public Service and Safety, for the acceptance and disposal of garbage and refuse to be collected by the City of Warren, after advertising for bids according to law, to enter into whatever contract(s) which may be useful or necessary to accomplish said purpose.

Section 2: That the aforementioned contract(s) shall be for a three year period, to be renewed by mutual agreement of the parties and under the same terms and conditions for an additional three year period.

Section 3: That the funds for the payment of the contract(s) to be entered into shall be paid from Account No. 706-552-530-000 Contracted Services.

Section 4: That the contract(s) shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 5: That Warren City Ordinance No. 12253/10 be, and the same hereby is, revoked in its entirety.

Section 6: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the integrity of the City of Warren and its environment may be more fully insured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay, and for the further reason that there exists a need for a new contract for such disposal. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
