THE FOLLOWING LEGISLATION WAS PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARREN AND SIGNED BY THE MAYOR ON THE 27TH DAY OF JULY, 2016

3601R	12660/16	An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the payment of specific orders or contracts upon receipt of certification of the Fiscal Officer of the sufficiency of funds for said expenditures, and declaring an emergency.
3602	12661/16	An ordinance for the purpose of: appropriating from the unappropriated, unencumbered balances of various city funds; to provide for the usual daily operations of the City of Warren and declaring an emergency.
3603R	12662/16	An ordinance for the purpose of appropriating from the Unappropriated unencumbered 2015 balances of various city funds; and appropriating from the unappropriated, anticipated 2016 receipts of various city funds; to provide for the usual daily operations of the City of Warren and declaring an emergency
3604	12663/16	An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety to enter into a contract(s) for professional services to conduct a comprehensive flow study of sewer systems in the City of Warren, and declaring an emergency.
3605	12664/16	An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety to apply for, accept and enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund Agreement on behalf of the City of Warren, Ohio a comprehensive flow study of sewer systems in the City of Warren, Ohio and designating a dedicated repayment source for the loan is: the Water Pollution Control Fund 703 and declaring an emergency.
3600	12665/16	An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety to advertise for bids and to enter into contact(s) that are necessary to secure and install equipment, materials and/or obtain professional services for a sewage sludge disc thickener system, and declaring an emergency.

3606	COLBERT	A resolution for the purpose of requesting and directing the Trumbull County Board of Elections to place before the electors, at and during the General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, the question of whether or not an ordinance for an additional income tax to be levied on and after January 1, 2017 at the rate of one-half of one percent (1/2%) per annum should be approved and passed, and declaring an emergency.
