TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE EASTGATE REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS TO IMPROVE THE RESERVE AVENUE BRIDGES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Reserve Avenue Bridges are Municipal Bridges in the City of Warren; and

WHEREAS, the Reserve Avenue Bridges are in need of improvements; and

WHEREAS, improvements on the Reserve Avenue Bridges are eligible for federal funding; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That Warren City Council hereby approves the filing of an application for federal funds programmed by the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments for those projects described hereafter.

Section 2: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to file an application for federal funds programmed by the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments, and to thereafter enter into any agreement(s) that may be useful or necessary, for the following:

Reserve Avenue Bridges (SFN 7860005) and (SFN 7860013)

The project will consist of milling and resurfacing the approach pavement, removal and replacement of guardrail, removal of existing asphalt overlay and placement of new concrete overlay on bridges, restriping, linear grading for sidewalk maintenance, new crushed aggregate slope protection at two abutments, refurbishing bearings, new vandal protection fence, concrete patching of curbs and substructure concrete, sealing of concrete surfaces, new tied concrete block mat for erosion control, replacement of any deteriorated cross frames, and spot repair by field cleaning and painting of galvanized structural steel.

Section 3: That the City of Warren acknowledges and understands the Eastgate "Funding Policy Guidelines" and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that the local share is required to match federal funds.
