TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WARREN TO ACCEPT MONIES, PURSUANT TO THE OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 715.01, FROM THE WARREN CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND TO ALLOW SAID MONIES TO BE USED FOR THE AUTHORIZED MUNICIPAL PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FOUR STUDENT RESOURCE OFFICERS FOR ONE SCHOOL YEAR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 12674/16

WHEREAS, Section 715.01 of the Ohio Revised Code allows a municipality to accept gifts and to use such gifts to further an authorized municipal purpose such as police protection; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the City hereby agrees to accept the sum of \$200,000., as a donation, from the Warren City School District.

Section 2: That said donated sum shall be used to further the Municipal purpose of providing four Student Resource Officers.

Section 3: That said donated sum shall be used to provide four police officers at various Warren City School locations.

Section 4: That said police officer coverage shall be provided for the 2016 - 2017 school year.

Section 5: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Warren City School District to accomplish the purpose of this Ordinance, said agreement to be first approved by the Director of Law.

Section 6: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the integrity of the policing efforts of the City of Warren, and the protection of those who live and work in the City of Warren, may be more fully insured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
