AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WARREN TO CONTRIBUTE \$20,778.00 TO THE TRUMBULL COUNTY TRANSIT BOARD FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2017, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 278///8

WHEREAS, the Trumbull County Transit Board was formed by the Trumbull County Board of Commissioners in 2011 to provide public transportation in Trumbull County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Niles relinquished its operation of the Niles Trumbull Transit System to the Trumbull County Transit Board as of the end of 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Trumbull County Transit Board has become the designated subrecipient of federal transit funding in Trumbull County in place of the City of Niles; and

WHEREAS, the Trumbull County Transit Board intends to apply for Federal transit funding and to that end must commit a certain amount of its local funds to match such Federal transit funds and to operate transit service; and

WHEREAS, other Trumbull County communities have expressed their intentions to also continue to commit certain of their funds to the operation of demand response public transit service and as local share to match potential Federal transit funding; and

WHEREAS, the Trumbull County Board of Commissioners supports the Trumbull County Transit Board in its efforts to fund and operate demand response public transit service, and has committed funds to the Trumbull County Transit Board to match Federal transit funding and to assure the delivery of public transit services in Trumbull County; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: For the Program Year 2017, the City of Warren shall contribute funding to the Trumbull County Transit Board to operate demand response public transit service within Trumbull County and to match Federal transit funds, such funds to be contributed on a fifty cents (\$0.50) per person basis derived from the 2010 census population of the City of Warren. Thus, the City of Warren shall contribute to the Trumbull County Transit Board the sum of \$20,778.00 to fund such transit services for Program Year 2017.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason to assure that the senior citizens and the disabled of Warren may continue to have available and affordable transportation without disruption.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
