TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT(S) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SANITARY SEWER LOCATED IN GROHL ALLEY IN THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 12799/18

WHEREAS, the businesses and residents adjoining Grohl Alley in the City of Warren, Ohio have experienced basement flooding as a result of excessive stormwater; and

WHEREAS, in August of 2014, flooding along Grohl Alley directed the City of Warren to request permission from the Ohio EPA to open a sanitary overflow located at High Street and North Park Avenue in the City of Warren to relieve flooding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren subsequently contracted with the URS Corporation - Ohio (nka - AECOM Technical Services, Incorporated) for a study of flooding in the downtown area; and

WHEREAS, said flooding study found some deficiencies in the sanitary sewer located in Grohl Alley in the City of Warren; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren as part of its commitment to residents and businesses wishes to correct these deficiencies; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and are hereby, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to enter into a contract(s) according to law for the construction of improvements to the sanitary sewer located in Grohl Alley in the City of Warren, Ohio.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the City of Warren. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
