AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO REQUEST PROPOSALS AND TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO ANY AND ALL AGREEMENT(S) FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND OPERATIONS OF THE PACKARD MUSIC HALL OF WARREN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Warren is the owner of real property commonly referred to as "The Packard Music Hall" located at 1703 Mahoning Avenue, Warren, Ohio 44484; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable for the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety to request proposals and to negotiate and enter into any and all agreement(s) necessary for the management and operations of the "Packard Music Hall" located at 1703 Mahoning Avenue, Warren, Ohio 44484; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Service and Safety, pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code, is hereby authorized to request proposals and to negotiate and enter into any and all agreement(s) necessary for the Management and Operations of the Packard Music Hall of, Warren, Ohio.

Section 2: That the Agreement(s) shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to disburse and or collect said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed with the management and operations of this property at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
