A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PRINCIPLES OF A COMPLETE STREETS POLICY TO PROVIDE A SAFE AND ACCESSIBLE, WELL-CONNECTED AND VISUALLY ATTRACTIVE SURFACE TRANSPORTATION NETWORK TO ENHANCE THE QUALITY OF LIFE IN THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO.

WHEREAS, a Complete Streets Policy provides a safe and accessible, well-connected and visually attractive surface transportation network that balances the needs of all users, including motorists, pedestrians, bicyclists, freight carriers, emergency responders, transit providers and adjacent land uses; and

WHEREAS, a Complete Streets Policy promotes a more healthy and livable community for residents and employees of all ages and abilities, including children to senior citizens and individuals with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, a Complete Streets Policy is intended to create a vision that the City of Warren will be a place where walking is safe, convenient and an enjoyable option for people of all ages and abilities to travel for work, school, shopping, recreation and other daily activities; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor, Director of Public Service and Safety and the Council of the City of Warren, hereby expresses its support and consideration that all planning, design, construction, reconstruction and maintenance activities produce safe and accessible surface transportation network improvements that allow all users of the public right of way to safely and conveniently reach their destination regardless of their chosen mode of transportation.

Section 2: That this Council and Administration gives its full support for a safe and accessible, well-connected and visually attractive surface transportation network that will enhance the quality of life in the City of Warren, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into immediate effect.
