AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT(S)TO SUPPLY, SELL AND DELIVER TO THE VILLAGE OF LORDSTOWN, OHIO QUANTITIES OF POTABLE WATER FOR THE BENEFIT OF CLEAN ENERGY FUTURETRUMBULL, LLC AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Of Warren, Ohio desires to enter into an agreement(s)with the Village of Lordstown, Ohio to supply, sell and deliver quantities of Potable Water for the benefit of Clean Energy Future-Trumbull, LLC; and

WHEREAS, in order for Clean Energy Future-Trumbull, LLC to be economically feasible, an economical water rate and long-term supply of sufficient quantities of potable water are needed; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warren has an adequate supply of potable water and desires to supply, produce and deliver to the Village of Lordstown, Ohio; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and are hereby, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to enter into an agreement(s) to supply, sell and deliver to the Village of Lordstown, Ohio quantities of potable water for the benefit of Clean Energy Future-Trumbull, LLC.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the integrity of the City of Warren's public water supply, treatment and distribution system may be more fully insured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
