AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS, AND TO THEREAFTER ENTER INTO ANY AND ALL CONTRACT(S), FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) SUTPHEN PUMPER MOUNTED ON A CUSTOM MONARCH CHASSIS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13040/2021

WHEREAS, the City of Warren has been awarded an American Recovery Plan of 2021 (ARPA) Grant; and

WHEREAS, said grant monies as may be permitted by law in conjunction with general fund monies may properly be used for the purchase by the City of Warren of a fire truck; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires that such a purchase of a fire truck take place;
NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized to advertise for bids for the purchase of a fire truck for use by the City of Warren's Fire Department, in accordance with plans and specifications therefore on file in the office of the Director of Public Service and Safety, and, after advertising for bids in accordance with law, to enter into whatever contract(s) that may be useful or necessary for such a purchase.

Section 2: That the total purchase price of such a truck shall not exceed five hundred and ninety five thousand, four hundred and thirty nine dollars (\$595,439.00).

Section 3: That the City's monies for the aforementioned purchase shall be paid from the appropriate fund or funds.

Section 4: That the contract(s) shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason that the integrity of the firefighting abilities of the City of Warren may be more fully ensured at the earliest possible time and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
