TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MERCY HEALTH FOR THE PURPOSE OF REMOVING INFLOW AND INFILTRATION TO OFFSET NEW SEWER FLOWS, TO SOLICIT REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS FROM ENGINEERING FIRMS, TO SOLICIT BIDS FROM CONSTRUCTION FIRMS AND ENTER INTO ANY AND ALL CONTRACT(S) NECESSARY TO MEET ANY OBLIGATIONS OF THE AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Mercy Health has requested to establish a new facility in our sanitary service area; and

WHEREAS, the City can offer this user authorization to connect, contingent upon Mercy sponsoring a separate sewer improvement project. Said sewer improvement project is necessary in order to enable Mercy to remove inflow and infiltration at levels that are acceptable to the City of Warren; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to enter into an Agreement with Mercy Health for the purpose of removing inflow and infiltration to offset new sewer flows.

Section 2: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to solicit requests for qualifications from engineering firms and solicit bids from construction firms and enter into any and all contract(s) necessary to meet the Agreement with Mercy Health.

Section 3: That the agreement and contract(s) shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, and for the further reason to meet the needs of Mercy Health without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
