A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF WARREN CITY COUNCIL'S PARTNERSHIP WITH THE COUNTY OF TRUMBULL TO ADOPT, UPDATE AND IMPLEMENT THE EXISTING TRUMBULL COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN IN AN EFFORT TO FURTHER IDENTIFY, DEFINE, AND CHARACTERIZE THE HAZARDS AFFECTING THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO AS WELL AS TO CONTINUE TO IDENTIFY AND PRIORITIZE PROJECTS THAT COULD LESSEN HAZARD VULNERABILITY AS A RESULT OF AN OCCURRENCE(S) OF A NATURAL, TECHNOLOGICAL, OR MAN-MADE HAZARD EVENT(S), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RESOLUTION NO. 4676/2021

WHEREAS, the Trumbull County Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency (EMA) has developed a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan that includes all hazards to which Trumbull County and its Municipalities are susceptible as a result of an occurrence(s) of a natural, technological or man-made hazard event(s); and

WHEREAS, significant structural, historical, and economic losses could result from an occurrence(s) of a natural, technological or man-made hazard event(s); and

WHEREAS, undertaking mitigation projects during pre-disaster periods could decrease the total losses that the City of Warren, Ohio would incur as a result of said hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, this Council of the City of Warren has a strong interest in reducing losses from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, the Hazard Mitigation Plan is a federal and state requirement to maintain eligibility for hazard mitigation funding and by that requirement, must be updated a minimum of every five years; and

WHEREAS, a cooperative, joint effort is a proven, efficient way to plan for and reduce hazard susceptibility in all government jurisdictions in Trumbull, County, Ohio.


WHEREAS, this Council of the City of Warren, Ohio has partnered with the County of Trumbull to adopt, update and implement the existing Trumbull County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan in an effort to further identify, define, and characterize the hazards affecting the City of Warren as well as to continue identifying and prioritizing projects that could lessen hazard vulnerability; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That this Council of the City of Warren, Ohio in partnership with the County of Trumbull hereby adopts, updates and implements the existing Trumbull County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan in an effort to further identify, define, and characterize the hazards affecting the City of Warren as well as to continue to identify and prioritize projects that could lessen hazard vulnerability as a result from an occurrence(s) of a natural, technological, or man-made hazard event(s).

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into immediate effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
