| 0137             | 13026/2021      | An ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to enter into agreement(s) with the Mayor of the Village of Lordstown, Ohio and to amend current agreements to provide for sewer service, and to provide for operation and maintenance of the sewer system for the Village of Lordstown Sanitary Sewer District's East Side Sanitary, Phase 1, and declaring an emergency. |
| 0131             | 13027/2021      | An ordinance for the purpose of approving the annexation of certain territory currently located in Howland Township and consisting of approximately 2.5890 acres of land contiguous to the City of Warren and declaring an emergency.  |
