AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT(S) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF NECESSARY IMPROVEMENTS AT THE PARKMAN ROAD WASTEWATER PUMPING STATION FOR THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13096/2022

WHEREAS, the City of Warren, Ohio owns, operates, and maintains a Public Wastewater Collection System including sanitary sewers and wastewater pumping stations to convey that wastewater to the Water Pollution Control Center for the purpose of converting that wastewater to clean water in conformation with all Government and EPA Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Parkman Road Pump Station was built in the early 1960s and upgraded in 1982 with little done since then and is in need of refurbishment in order to continue to meet EPA standards; and

WHEREAS, the entire Pump Station will be refurbished under Phase 2 of the Capital Improvement Plan but replacement of at least two of the four pumps and the replacement of the existing manual mechanical bar screen are critically needed to be expedited to reduce the chance of potential station failure; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, Ohio to advertise for bids and enter into a contract(s) according to law to provide and install equipment and materials as needed for these critical improvements to the Parkman Road Wastewater Pumping Station.

Section 2: That any contract(s) to be entered into or participated in for improvements to the Parkman Road Wastewater Pumping Station shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety, and for the further reason to maintain the integrity of the City of Warren, Ohio Waste Water Facilities. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
