TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE DOWNTOWN WARREN MULTI-USE TRAIL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13102/2022

WHEREAS, this Council supports and approves of a trail that would connect Burbank Park, Packard Park, and Perkins Park for the use and enjoyment of its citizens and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Downtown Multi-Use Trail will further the City's efforts to connect the existing Riverwalk along Perkins Park to Packard Park and Burbank Park; and

WHEREAS, this Council is ready to proceed with a feasibility study to accomplish the abovementioned project; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into an agreement for the feasibility study of the Downtown Multi-Use Trail.

Section 2: That the agreement shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety, and for the further reason to complete the Downtown Multi-Use Trail Study in a timely fashion, during conducive weather, and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
