TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE MATCHING FUNDS TO TRUMBULL NEIGHBORHOOD PARTNERSHIP FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT TO BE INSTALLED AT BURBANK PARK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13105/2022

WHEREAS, Trumbull Neighborhood Partnership has received grant funding in the amount of \$40,000 from the William Swanston Charitable Foundation through the Community Foundation of the Mahoning Valley, and \$11,500 from Creating Healthy Communities to install playground equipment at Burbank Park; and

WHEREAS, matching funds in the amount of \$50,000 is being requested from the recent Environmental Protection Agency Settlement; and

WHEREAS, Burbank Park, situated in the northwest part of the City, is currently being considered as part of a feasibility study for the Downtown Multi-Use Trail; and

WHEREAS, the monies used for playground equipment will further expand the City's efforts in enhancing its parks for recreation and enjoyment of City residents and visitors; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter an agreement to provide \$50,000 in matching funds for playground equipment for Burbank Park.

Section 2: That the agreement shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety, and for the further reason to complete installation of the playground equipment in a timely fashion, during conducive weather, and without undue delay. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
