AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, OHIO, TO SOLICIT STATEMENTS OF QUALIFICATIONS FROM ENGINEERING FIRMS, ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO CONTRACT(S) FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW SPLASH PAD SEWER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13137/2022

WHEREAS, the City of Warren owns, operates, and maintains a sanitary sewage collection system in conformity with all Government and EPA regulations; and

WHEREAS, a new Splash Pad was constructed behind Packard Music Hall in 2021 and must discharge the used water from that Splash Pad to the sewer along Mahoning Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the original 6-inch sewer from the restrooms at the back of the Packard Music Hall parking lot is in poor condition; and

WHEREAS, the water from the Splash Pad requires operation of a pump station to discharge to the previously existing 6-inch sewer; and

WHEREAS, a newly installed 6-inch sewer could be constructed to flow by gravity to the Mahoning Sewer without need of a pump station, thereby saving on the associated electricity and maintenance; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be, and hereby are, authorized to solicit Statements of Qualifications from Engineering firms, advertise for bids from construction contractors and enter into contract(s) for the design, bidding, provision of materials and construction of a new Splash Pad sewer.

Section 2: That the any said contract(s) to be entered into or participated in for the design, bidding, provision of materials for and the construction of the Splash Pad Sewer shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
