AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING
ORDINANCE NUMBER 11461/01 THAT ESTABLISHED
CHAPTER 753, WHICH PROHIBITED BODY PIERCING, AND
THE VARIOUS SECTIONS THEREOF, WITHIN THE CITY OF
WARREN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13143/2022

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2001, Council passed Ordinance No. 11461/01, establishing Chapter 753 within the Codified Ordinances of the City of Warren, which prohibited body piercing and the operation of those businesses that offered body piercing services within the City, as well as penalties for the violations thereof; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined the need for a prohibition on body piercing and/or the operation of businesses that offer body piercing no longer exists, as state laws are established that regulate such businesses; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to repeal this prohibition; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That Chapter 753, and the various sections thereof, including definitions, prohibition, and penalties, be and the same hereby are, repealed within the Codified Ordinances of the City of Warren.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety, and for the further reason that the change is necessary to permit business to operate within the City of Warren. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take immediate effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage and approval by the Mayor.
