TITLE

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WARREN, TO SOLICIT REQUEST(S) FROM AN ENGINEERING FIRM FOR QUALIFICATIONS AND DESIGN IMPROVEMENTS AND ENTER INTO ANY AND ALL CONTRACT(S) NECESSARY FOR WATER FILTRATION PLANT, PUMP STATION, AND WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13187/2022

WHEREAS, the City of Warren owns, operates, and maintains a public Water Filtration Plant (WFP) for the purpose of converting reservoir water to clean, potable water to conform with all Government and EPA Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Water Filtration Plant is in need of refurbishments and upgrades to meet EPA standards; and

WHEREAS, an inspection and assessment must be done to determine the capital improvement priorities, design specifications, and estimated costs for the Water Filtration Plant, the Pump Station, and the Water Main improvements; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Public Service and Safety be, and are hereby, authorized, for and on behalf of the City of Warren, to solicit request(s) for qualifications from an engineering firm(s) for qualifications and design improvements and enter into any and all contract(s) necessary to complete this inspection and assessment.

Section 2: That any and all contract(s) to be entered into or participated in to design improvements to the Water Filtration Plant, the Pump Station, and the Water Main shall first be approved by the Law Director, and the City Auditor be, and hereby is, authorized to disburse said funds upon receipt of the proper vouchers, signed by the proper persons, for the stated purpose and for no other purpose.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety, and for the further reason to maintain the integrity of the City of Warren's Water Filtration Facility, Pump Station, and Water Main. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
