AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING AND REPLACING "SECTION 2: FEES" OF CHAPTER 1757 "ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR BODY ART TATTOOING AND PIERCING" WITHIN THE CITY OF WARREN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 13191/2022

WHEREAS, this Council voted on and passed Ordinance No. 13143/2022 on July 27, 2022, which repealed and replaced Chapter 1757 "Establishing Regulations for Body Art Tattooing and Piercing" within the City of Warren; and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2022, the Warren City Board of Health passed Resolution #284A, which updated the fee schedule for tattoo specialist licenses, body piercing specialist licenses, tattoo establishment licenses, and body piercing establishment licenses; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to adopt Warren City Board of Health Resolution #284A into Chapter 1757; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Warren, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That, "Section 2: Fees" of Chapter 1757 of the Warren Codified Ordinances shall be repealed in its entirety.

Section 2: That, "Section 2: Fees" of Chapter 1757 of the Warren Codified Ordinances shall be replaced with the following:

"Section 2: Fees

- A. Tattoo Specialist License and Body Piercing Specialist Licenses: A Tattoo Specialist and Body Piercing Specialist License are separate and each application shall be accompanied by a fee in the amount of \$50.00 annually. This license shall expire annually on December 31 and shall not be prorated nor refunded for partial use.
- B. Tattoo Establishment License and Body Piercing Establishment Licenses: A Tattoo Establishment License and Body Piercing Establishment License are separate and each application shall be accompanied by a fee in the amount of \$150.00 annually. This license shall expire annually on December 31 and shall not be prorated nor refunded for partial use. Any change in ownership shall require a new application and license, with payment of fees therefore."

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety, and for the further reason that the change is necessary to be consistent with Warren Board of Health resolutions. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take immediate effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage and approval by the Mayor.
